

Welcome to Summer Camp 2010! We are really looking forward to a great week together. There are a few details you'll want to know before we head up to the mountains.

Departure: We will meet at church at **7am**, Sunday, Aug. 1st in the East Lot.

Return: We will be back around 6:00pm on Sat., Aug. 7th.

Check IN: There are 3 important things that will be happening at check in this year:

1. **Registration:** Hume Lake is now doing all medical forms online. Please fill out the form ASAP. If you have not received an email from Hume please contact our office (ext 150) ASAP. This will be the place to make final payments.
2. **Medical Check:** Hume requires a quick medical check before allowing us to come to camp. This check is a simple form, filled out by nurses that will be at check in. To see this form ahead of time please go to: www.1bl.org/students. If your student has had a concussion or other head injury, or a cast within a week of going to camp, Hume requires a doctor's note clearing them to come.
3. **Paintball/High Ropes Sign up:** To help students better plan their spending money, there will be a table at check in to sign up for paintball and the high ropes course. They must sign up at check in to participate. The cost is \$10 for each. **CASH ONLY.**

Luggage: Each person will be allowed one suitcase, a sleeping bag, pillow, and backpack. Please use the luggage tag that is included in the letter to mark your suitcase. We encourage students to not pack more than they can carry.

Things to Bring: Sleeping bag, pillow, towels, toiletries, casual modest clothing, Bible, notebook, pen, and flashlight.

Girls: Modest one-piece bathing suits. No two-piece of any kind (including tankinis) .Also, no short shorts, no-halter or midriff -tops, or tank tops with straps less than an inch thick.

Guys: no Speedos, no sagging, and shirts must be worn when walking around camp.

Things to leave at home: Drugs (unless prescribed by a doctor & in the original bottle), alcohol, tobacco, fireworks, firearms, electronic devices.

Extra Money: We will be stopping for lunch on the way up to camp and on the way home. There are many recreation options at camp and Hume suggest \$35-\$50 for these activities, camp pictures, food, etc. Excessive amounts of money are not suggested. **Do not pack your food money!**

Spirit Day: Hume is packed full of awesome things to do during the week that includes a great recreation program. During rec you'll have the chance to play some fun & competitive games. Even if you're not into rec you'll love Spirit Day. It's a great chance to get dressed up in wacky clothes & cheer on your team. If you've never been to Hume don't underestimate how much you should dress up! This year's theme is: "**Tabards & Staches.**"
