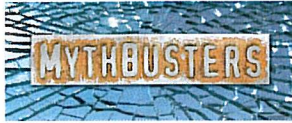

I heard about this cop who got shot at point blank range, and his belt buckle stopped the bullet." And you think, is that actually *true*? Or is it an urban legend?
