Evangelism is Only for Those Who Have the Gift
Community Group Study Questions
Colossians 4:2-6 and selected passages

1. How do you feel when you hear the word "evangelism?" Scared? Excited? Indifferent? Do you believe that evangelism is a "gift" (*Ephesians 4:11*)? Why or why not? Do you believe that you have this "gift?"

2. If someone asked you what the "gospel" was, how would you answer them? Is your explanation or description of the gospel consistent with that of the Bible (*1 Corinthians 15:1-4; Galatians 1:8-9; Romans 1:16*)?

3. What should we continually "devote" ourselves to pray for (*Colossians 4:2; Matthew 6:10*)? How is prayer related to thanksgiving (cf. *1 Thessalonians 5:16-18*)? What difference can devoted prayer make in your life (*Luke 18:1*)?

4. Why do Paul and Timothy ask the Colossians to pray for the success of their ministry (*Colossians 4:3-4*)? Why is prayer foundational to any work of ministry (and in particular, evangelism; *Acts 14:27; 2 Corinthians 2:12; Ephesians 6:18-20*)?
