Many Paths Lead to God
Community Group Study Questions
John 14:6; Acts 4:12 and selected passages

1. When people say "many paths lead to God," what do they mean? Why do some people believe this idea of universalism? Do you believe it? How would you engage with someone who believes that many paths lead to God?
2. What does Jesus say about getting to God (*John 14:6; cf. 10:9*)? Is His statement an arrogant one? Why is Jesus' claim different than those of other religious leaders (*John 1:14; Ephesians 2:13, 18; Hebrews 10:19-20*)?
3. How do people view us when we tell them that Jesus is the only path (or way) to God (*cf. Luke 21:16-17*)? Why does this truth offend so many people (*2 Corinthians 4:4; John 12:37-40; Isaiah 53:1; 6:10*)?
4. Share about a time when you talked to someone about Jesus being the only way to salvation. How did the person respond? How did you feel as you told them? Scared? Embarrassed? Confident?
