

4. Do you view God as an unwavering companion, who walks with you through both good times and bad (*Psalm 23:4-5; Isaiah 43:1-2; Acts 18:10*)? Where has He brought you immeasurable peace during hard times? How might you be able to encourage someone to seek God's comfort during their trials (*2 Corinthians 1:3-4*)?

5. Do you have an eternal "home" or is this life all you've got? Do you give thanks when you think about dwelling in God's presence for all eternity (*Psalm 23:6; 27:4-6; Revelation 21:3*)? Who do you know that needs to hear about Jesus Christ so that they can also dwell in God's presence for eternity?

6. How will you respond to the realities raised here in *Psalm 23*? To those who believe in Him, God is a shepherd, He has given His word as a "map," He is a companion, and has promised an eternal home. During this Thanksgiving season, remember Jesus and what He has done for you and give thanks (*1 Peter 2:21-25; Psalm 136:1*)!
